It is the responsibility of exhibitors to ensure delivery of their fleeces to the Fleece Competition Area by 9.30am and remain until 4.00pm.

Fleeces remain the responsibility of the owners throughout the show. The organisers will not accept any liability for loss or damage to any fleece. Fleeces that are artificially stained or fastened with any form of twine will be eliminated.
